

Critical Writing Award

Application Deadline: Monday, March 5, 2018

Any undergraduate student may submit any single piece of critical exposition originally written for an English course at Iowa State University (including course papers submitted during the current academic year). The amount of the two awards varies, up to \$200 each.

Undergraduate essays will be judged separately. Criteria for evaluation include originality of thesis, command of material, and quality of exposition.

Submissions must be typewritten, double-spaced, and no longer than 30 pages. Recommended length is 6–15 pages for undergraduate essays and 12–20 pages for graduate essays.

Completed undergraduate applications (including this page and a form cover sheet) should be returned to an English undergraduate adviser, or taken to 203 Ross.
